#### quarterly tonnage dues and maximum contribution—all applicants

Full Members who are Fabricators shall pay a tonnage fee of \$1.85 per ton each quarter for all steel fabricated, produced or manufactured for use in structures, including structural and miscellaneous steel. The tonnage fee for the first 400 tons fabricated is included with the annual fee. This tonnage fee is capped at a maximum annual payment of \$80,000. Members still must report all tonnage, including the first 400 tons, on their quarterly invoice.

Full Members who are Fabricators shall pay an additional bridge tonnage fee of \$1.40 per ton each quarter on all steel utilized in the fabrication of steel bridges and bridge-like structures. This fee is not exempt from the payment for the initial 400 tons but is capped so the total structural steel tonnage payment plus bridge tonnage payment does not exceed \$80,000 annually.
